NEW SCHOOL JOINS HULL CHILDREN'S DENTAL EDUCATION CHARITY

Croxby Primary School is the latest recruit to the Teeth Team Charity – joining thousands of children already benefitting from a supervised tooth brushing programme.

Croxby Primary on Bricknell Avenue in Cottingham is part of The Consortium Academy Trust and teaches more than 300 pupils. Teeth Team was rolled out across the school last month and is already proving popular with the pupils.

Teeth Team is a school-based supervised tooth brushing programme, supporting thousands of pupils across 24 primary schools. The programme incorporates daily tooth brushing in class, clinical dental assessments, applications of fluoride varnish and the subsequent signposting for accessing primary and secondary dental care. It is a collaborative working partnership between local dental practices, schools, and parents to improve the dental health of children.

Chris Groombridge, Chair of Teeth Team, commented: "We are absolutely delighted that Croxby Primary has joined our family of schools across the region. We know the programme will greatly benefit the oral health of pupils at Croxby, just as it is doing for thousands of children in our other Teeth Team schools."

The toothbrush racks hold 10 toothbrushes and are designed so they do not touch, for hygiene reasons. They are provided in different colours and symbols along with matching stickers for the toothbrushes; there is also space for a name to be written. The children are easily able to identify their toothbrush by name, colour, and symbol.

Paul Tennyson from The Toothbrush Rack Company said: "Our primary objective is to support oral health providers with the highest quality resources to deliver effective oral health programmes and reduce tooth decay in young children.
